- Search for your class by entering a key word in the title or the course number. Click Submit. (Enter information in only one field for broader results.)

- Enter your personal information, certify your identification and click Submit.
 You must provide your Social Security Number.
- 5. Optional: Enter your **Additional Registration Information** and click **Submit**.

- If you want to register for additional classes, select **Search for more classes** under "Choose one of the following." If you are finished selecting the class(es) for which you want to register, select **Register now (check out)**. Select your **Payment Type**. Click **Submit**.
