Knowing how to pick the right plan to meet your needs is important to ensure you get the best coverage at the lowest cost. Navigating Medicare.gov will arm you with the knowledge to navigate Medicare's plan-finder tool to make an informed decision. You will be provided a step-by-step guide to using Medicare.gov to address these questions:

- How much will my prescriptions cost?
- Which Medicare drug plan will cover my prescriptions?
- Where can I get the best prices for my prescriptions?

 You must provide your Social Security Number.
- 5. Optional: Enter your **Additional Registration** Information and click **Submit**.

- If you want to register for additional classes, select Search for more classes under "Choose one of the following." If you are finished selecting the class(es) for which you want to register, select Register now (check out). Select your Payment Type. Click Submit.
- 7. Enter your payment information. Click Submit.
