We are committed to helping you achieve your goals! Follow the steps on this guide to apply for the Human Services Program. A review of your academic performance and the following requirements are utilized to score your admission placement in the program.

This program accepts students in both the <u>Fall and Spring semesters</u>. This program offers courses in the face-to-face format, as well as some courses in an online format. The program cannot be completed completely online. See program website for additional information and option details.

- Students may enroll in **one** Human Services Certificate at a time.
 - Alcohol and Drug Counseling Certificate
 - Peer Support Certificate

Program Acceptance into Human Services:

Applications will be reviewed when ALL Program requirements are submitted. The program utilizes a selection process of all complete applications to determine acceptance into the program. Applications with incomplete or missing requirements at the time of selection will not be reviewed. The application for the program will remain open until the end of the application period and/or until the program spots are filled. Please note the following:

- Applicants MUST resubmit all documentation during each application period.
- Applicants with Program Requirements unmet, will not have their application reviewed for acceptance, until the end of the term AND after the submission of all requirements.

☐ Demonstrate Appropriate Level of Proficiency in Reading and/or Math:

- Must have completed ENGL0985 or higher or place into ENGL1010 or higher
- Must have completed MATH0900 or higher or place into MATH0950 or higher
 Proficiency can be demonstrated with placement test scores OR course completion. For details related to placement testing or to schedule a placement test go to https://www.southeast.edu/nextgenerationaccuplacer/.
- □ Students complete college General Education courses along with program coursework. Students must receive a final grade of C or above for any Human Services courses to count the credits toward any Human Services degree or certificate. Submit official transcripts showing college coursework completed at a college/university other than SCC, to SCC Admissions Office 8800 O Street Lincoln, NE 68520.

periods. For students interesting in starting:
Spring Semester (January): Please apply September 1 st – October 15 th .
• First review of completed applications will begin on October 15; the application will remain open until all program seats are full.
Notification of acceptance will occur after November 15 th .
Fall Semester (August): Please apply February 1 st – March 15 th .
• First review of completed applications will begin on March 15th; the application will remain open until all program seats are full.
Notification of acceptance will occur after April 15 th .
Incomplete applications will not be reviewed if missing program requirements.

☐ Complete Practicum Requirements: Human Services practicum requirements must be completed at the time of the application to the program. Submit documentation to the Health Sciences Building (HSB 230) or email: healthsciences@southeast.edu.

- Proof of current Heartsaver CPR AED, American Heart Association only
- Complete Student Health Statement (see documentation form on program websitehttps://www.southeast.edu/academics/files/StudentHealthStatement.pdf)

Note: Students are required to complete a Criminal Background Check and drug testing during the first term in the program. The results of the background check and drug testing could result in student not being able to take certain classes or complete the program.
