

Financial Support

Learn to Dream Scholarship gives economically disadvantaged students the opportunity to complete up to 60 semester credit hours at one of the Southeast Community College campuses in Beatrice, Lincoln and Milford, without paying tuition and fees. Students attending high school in SCC's <u>15-county area</u>, may be eligible!

Access College Early (ACE)

SENCAP COORDINATOR & SENCAP FACILIATOR INFORMATION

To support our portfolio option in our program and efficiency, we have realigned our team for 2023-2024! Our program will have SENCAP Coordinators & SENCAP Facilitators. Below is a brief description of their student-centered duties.

SENCAP Coordinators will continue to routinely serve high schools in our 15-county region to meet with students to provide ongoing, individualized support designed to help students successfully transition to their next step after graduation.

- Will assist with orienting students to SCC online resources including Self-Services (online drop/add), The Hub, CANVAS, etc.
- Will provide interpretation support of placement and career assessments to assist students in identifying career interests, goals, academic preparedness, skills, and talents.
- Will collaborate and communicate with high school faculty, counselors, and administration to increase dual enrollment and the number of students who transition to SCC.
- Will also accompany students to Discovery Days & Career Days.
- Will assist with coursework and support student efforts to make certain the college course requirements and dual credit requirements are met.

SENCAP Facilitators will be organizing, planning, and overseeing the day-to-day facilitation and operation of the SENCAP Portfolio for the Career Academies in their assigned service area/region operating within area high schools.

- Will be working directly with the SENCAP & Dual Credit Administrators and designated high school personnel on all aspects of the portfolio.
- Will show communication and coordination with SENCAP coordinators, high school administrators, counselors, dual-credit instructors, and high school students.
- Will be responsible for teaching and grading SENCAP online curriculum through Canvas, reporting student progress and grades to high schools in the assigned region.
- Will manage and facilitate SENCAP portfolio coursework and support student efforts to make certain the college course requirements and SENCAP requirements are met.
