OVERVIEW

Year 1: Practical Nursing (PN) Diploma

- Two semesters of classroom instruction, lab, and clinical experiences
- Eligible to take the NCLEX-PN Exam upon completion & begin working as an LPN
- Required starting point for all students who intend to pursue the ADN to become a Registered Nurse (RN)

Year 2: Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN)

- Two additional semesters of advanced nursing education
- Eligible to take the NCLEX-RN Exam upon completion and begin working as a Registered Nurse (RN)

Note: Current LPNs may enter directly into Year 2 of the program beginning Fall 2027.

PREREQUISITE COURSES (FOR FALL 2026 AND BEYOND)

All students entering the new curriculum will be required to complete the following prerequisite courses:

Required Before Starting Year 1 (PN Diploma):

- GELO 2: Written Communication (3 credits)
- GELO 3: BIOS 1140 Human Anatomy or BIOS 2250 – Human Anatomy & Physiology I (4 credits)
- GELO 5: BIOS 2130 Human Physiology or BIOS 2260 – Human Anatomy & Physiology II (4 credits)

Required Before Graduation with ADN:

- ACFS 1015 Success at SCC (1 credit)
- GELO 1: Oral Communication (3 credits)
- GELO 4 or GELO 6: (3 credits)
 - Highly recommended:
 - SOCI 1010 Introduction to Sociology
 - SOCI 1020 Diversity in Society
