You will learn about the priority assessments and management strategies for head, neck, spinal, and extremity injuries in athletes, heat and cold emergencies, bleeding wounds, and allergic reactions that you may see at athletic events. The intended audience is BLS EMS professionals who may be called upon to provide care to athletes and spectators. You will participate in handson practice with tourniquets, splints, pelvic slings, and spinal immobilizations devices.

Participants are welcome to bring equipment from their EMS Department for discussion and focused practice. Content also includes a "Stop the Bleed" Instructor Orientation to help guide you through the process of certifying to teach lifesaving hemorrhage control education in your community.



**Instructor: Curtis Olson** is a nurse and educator with experience in EMS and in urban and rural hospital emergency departments. He is currently the Trauma Outreach and Injury Prevention Coordinator at a level II trauma center in Lincoln. Nebraska. Olson's EMS experience includes a year as a paramedic-firefighter with Lincoln Fire & Rescue, and three years as a volunteer EMT with the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Rescue Squad in the Maryland suburbs of Washington, D.C. Olson completed Paramedic certification

training at Creighton University in 1998, passed the Certified Emergency Nurse exam in 2007 and the Trauma Certified Registered Nurse exam in 2023. He has taught extensively on healthcare topics at public education events, workplace trainings, and in academic settings. He has presented at national, regional and state nursing and EMS conferences from coast to coast.
