

10 Tips to have the Best Campus Visit

- Research SCC's website before coming to campus. Take a look around and make a list of things that you want to see while on campus.
- 2. Write down specific questions that you have about SCC or things related to making your college decision. We'll do our best to answer your questions and connect you with the resources you need to make the best decision for you.
- Plan ahead. Your visit will take about two hours. Also, wear comfortable shoes.
- 4. Talk to as many people as you can! Seek out the advice and perspective of instructors, current students and staff to gain a full understanding of our campuses.

- 6. Check out social and study spaces. Yes, you'll be spending a lot of time in the classroom, but we also want you to feel at home, meet new people, and find a good study space that meets your needs.
