Some areas of our campuses do not receive strong cell signal. This can cause issues with voice calls, text messages, and authenticator apps. Most phones can use "Wi-Fi Calling" to avoid these issues.

## Connect to the 'eduroam' Wi-Fi network


- 1. Enter your username. Use the ab12345@southeast.edu format
- 2. Enter your usual SCC password
- 3. Select "trust" or "trust on first use" if prompted

- 2. Toggle-on "Wi-Fi Calling"
- 3. Enter an emergency contact address if

prompted



On an iPhone...

- Select Settings > Cellular > Wi-Fi Calling \*
- 2. Toggle-on "Wi-Fi Calling on this iPhone"
- 3. Enter an emergency contact address if

prompted
