Principles of Computed Tomography

This course offers specialized patient care, contrast media identification and administration and safe radiation practices as it relates to computed tomography. Emphasis is placed on system operations and components, image processing and display, image quality, and artifacts.

Computed Tomography Procedures

This course is designed to cover cross-sectional anatomy as it relates to the CT imaging process. Emphasis is placed on the identification of the anatomical structures of the chest, abdomen, pelvis, neck, head, and musculoskeletal system on CT images. An overview of routine and specialized CT procedures, along with scanning protocols, are included.
