There is a tremendous demand for skilled drivers all across the United States. If you enjoy being on the road, why not get paid for it? Our Professional Truck Driver Training program prepares students for both intrastate and interstate commerce. This is a 10.5-week intensive truck driving course. Students learn to operate articulated vans and flatbeds. Training includes driving on city streets and rural roads, as well as two-lane and interstate highways.

This program is located on the Lincoln Campus. Graduates will obtain a Class A Commercial Drivers License.

Students will sharpen their driving skills on the private SCC backing concourse and perimeter road before progressing to highway and city driving. On-campus housing is not available, but accommodations may be made at the Milford Campus.



Graduate Earnings

Recent graduates report an average starting salary of \$45,000 per year. Drivers with three years' experience average \$52,000 annually.

Special Program Requirements Prior to Start of Class:

1. Complete Application for Admission.
2. Complete course placement test and achieve program level scores or provide transcript showing completion of previous college coursework.
3. Minimum age of 18 years. Federal regulations require the applicant to be at least 21 years old to work in Interstate Commerce.
4. High School Diploma or GED®.
5. Valid motor vehicle operator's license.
6. Copy of driving record for the past three years from the Department of Motor Vehicles.
7. Physically qualified under the Department of Transportation regulations. Must have a certified medical examiner complete the form.
8. Pass a D.O.T. pre-employment drug screen at a SAMHSA approved location no sooner than 30 days prior to the start date.
9. Obtain a Class A Commercial Learners Permit by taking three written tests at the DMV. (Combination vehicles, air brakes and general knowledge)

Estimated Expenses

Nebraska Resident tuition/fee rate is \$69.50 per credit hour. Out-of-state tuition/fee rate is \$83.50 per credit hour. Graduation fee is \$25.

Housing is available at Beatrice and Milford campuses only. Tuition, books and fees are dependent upon classes taken each quarter.

Students should plan a budget that includes room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Financial aid is not available for this program.
