The **General Studies** focus is for students who plan to earn their degree in one of Southeast Community College's Health Sciences programs and will take required general studies courses before enrolling in their chosen program.



The **Transfer** focus is for students who want to transfer their credits to a four-year institution to complete a bachelor's degree in a health sciences or pre-professional health program.

- Students in the **General Studies** focus for an SCC program will have targeted and effective advising about pre-professional health academic programs and health sciences careers.
- Students who plan to **transfer** to another institution will have targeted and effective advising but should work closely with their transfer institution for transfer requirements.
