### More about the program

- Practicums begin during your second semester, giving you the opportunity to apply your education and gain experience in a real-life setting.
- Lead group activities at a community agency under the supervision of an instructor.
- Complete role plays of interviewing skills, counseling techniques and group therapy sessions to develop your listening and communication skills, preparing you for on-the-job experiences.
- SCC's coursework provides a strong foundation to excel in advanced degrees upon completion of the program. You can work in the field or continue your education toward a bachelor's degree in the areas of social work, behavioral sciences, human development, human relations, or human services.
