- Your classroom instruction will be supplemented by driving on city streets, rural roads, two-lane and interstate highways, and a large concourse on campus.
- Our program costs just under \$1,200 (in-state), and Gap Tuition Assistance is available for those who qualify at www.southeast.edu/gaptuitionassistance.
- **Two** sessions are available each **fall** and **spring** term, and **one** session is available in the **summer**, giving you the flexibility you need to start your trucking career when it's convenient for you.
