

Southeast COMMUNITY COLLEGE COVID-19 Self-Screening

Every day ask yourself the following screening questions **PRIOR** to entering any SCC building.

Do you have **ONE** of the following?

- Fever of over 100.4° F
- Onset of Shortness of Breath OR Difficulty Breathing
- New Onset of Dry Cough
- New Onset of Loss of Taste or Smell

Do you have **2 or more** of the following, lasting more than 24 hours without a known cause?

- Chills Longer than Two Hours
- Congestion and/or Runny Nose
- Nausea, Vomiting, or Diarrhea
- Sore Throat
- Headache
- Muscle Pain

Have you had contact with COVID-19?

- Have you had close contact with someone positive for COVID-19? (Contact longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet without a face covering or residing with someone who is positive?)
- Have you been directed to self-isolate due to a positive COVID-19 test result or for having contact with someone with COVID-19?

If you answered **YES** to ANY of the above questions, **do NOT** enter any SCC buildings. Instead:

- Contact your doctor or seek medical care.
- Got tested for COVID-19.
- Self-isolate. Do not enter any SCC building until you have a negative COVID-19 test result or have been cleared by a medical professional.
- Contact your instructor to discuss educational options
- Submit TIPS report
