Assessment/Course Placement

All Southeast Community College students must demonstrate academic readiness through at least one of the following:

- ACCUPLACER/ACT/SAT/COMPASS/ASSET scores as required by Program of Study within the past five years in Reading, English and Math.
- ACCUPLACER/COMPASS/ASSET are administered through the Assessment Office on all SCC campuses.
- Evidence of three or more transfer credit hours with a grade of "C" or better from an accredited postsecondary institution in English, Math and courses demonstrating reading ability.

English

- Use of correct punctuation and sentence structure to edit sentences if needed.
- Ability to rewrite sentences without changing original meaning of sentence. (Construction Shift)

Reading

- Reading comprehension, inferencing
- Understanding the relationship between two sentences. Example: supporting, contradictory, repetitive, cause & effect, problem & solution

Math

- Mastery of fractions, decimals, percentages
- Understanding algebraic expressions - (+, -, ×, ÷), factoring, operations, and simplifying
- Translating written phrases into algebraic expressions
